INFORMATION AND MANAGEMENT OF COOKIES

What are cookies (and similar technologies)

Cookies are small text files that the sites visited by the user send to its terminal-computer, laptop, tablet, smartphone, etc.-where they are stored before being re-transmitted to the same sites at the next visit to the same user.

Sailing on site, you can only receive cookies sent directly from our site and managed by our company.

A-Cookies managed by our company

Technical Cookies are used for the purposes indicated later and without the need for consent from the user, but can be disabled.

At any time, in accordance with d.lgs no.196 / 03, you can get, by sending a request to the email butangas@butangas.it, the confirmation of the processing of data in question and of the purpose of the processing, the source of the data, the logic applied to the processing, an indication of all the items listed above as well as:

- Updating, rectification, integration of data;
- The cancellation, anonymization or blocking of data in violation of the law.

By sending a request to the email address above, you may also object at any time to the further processing of your data for creating a profile.

B-technical Cookies

These cookies are designed to maintain proper operation of navigation or to expand the functionality or performance of the site. They are not used for other purposes and are managed by our company.

They are divided into:

- a) <u>cookies of navigation or of session</u>: are designed to ensure the normal navigation and use of the site, using different options or services. These cookies allow, for example, to store the elements that characterize a particular request, make a purchase, sign the participation in an event;
- b) <u>Cookies analytics</u>: they are cookies that collect information on the number of users and how they visit the site, such as information on what pages or sections of pages are most viewed and which pages are receiving reports of malfunctions. The information is collected in aggregate and anonymous form;
- c) <u>functional cookies</u>: they are cookies which allow the user the navigation in function of a set of selected criteria (such as language, text characters, browser type) in order to improve the service rendered. All these cookies are enabled automatically.

Name	Type of cookie	Description
Google Analytics	Monitoring Technical	It collects anonymous usage statistics and site performance. To disable it, follow the instructions at the link https://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout
PHPSESID	Session Technical	Cookies native PHP and allows websites to store data on the state of the serialization. It is used to establish a user session and to communicate data through a temporary cookie, commonly called session cookies. Since the cookie PHPSESID has a time limit, it disappears when you close your browser.
